

#### **New Emergency Operations Center to Transform Crisis Response**

A cutting-edge Emergency Operations Center (EOC) is set to be sent out for bid in September 2024. Aimed at enhancing crisis response capabilities, it's scheduled for completion in 2026. This state-of-the-art facility is designed to withstand severe weather, earthquakes, and other hazards, ensuring operational integrity during emergencies.

The new EOC spans 4400 square feet with a modular design for rapid reconfiguration to meet various emergency needs. The open-plan workspace promotes seamless communication and coordination among agencies, enhancing collaborative efforts. Key features include a media room, conference room, kitchen, two bunk rooms, and a dedicated radio room. The EOC/Training room can accommodate 48 people, providing ample space for operations and drills.

The EOC will house representatives from fire, police, medical, and other services, fostering a unified command structure. Regular educational programs and workshops will inform and equip residents, while the center serves as a hub for public information during crises.

The project is grant-funded, with additional financial support from the county. Meadors is the architect on record, ensuring the facility meets the highest standards of design and functionality. The new EOC represents a significant advancement in emergency preparedness and response. By leveraging technology, fostering collaboration, and engaging the community, it will become a model of resilience, safeguarding lives and property, and enhancing regional safety and security.
