Our purpose is to gather information from citizens to help us identify areas in Calhoun County that are suffering from poor drainage, flooding, and/or erosion due to storm water runoff. The information you provide will be incorporated into a Storm Water Flood Study. The result will be a Stormwater Masterplan which prioritizes problem areas and creates a plan to make improvements.
