- 1. Bessie Wright was listed on the agenda to discuss a mobile home issue, but was not present at the meeting.
- 2. Chief Magistrate, Jeff Bloom, appeared to give an update to Council. He stated that the Magistrate Court is running very smoothly, and that both Judge Cynthia Keller and Judge Joseph Teague are doing good jobs.

### Resolutions

- 1. An amended **Resolution 19-2021** SETTING THE MILLAGE AND LOCAL OPTION SALES TAX CREDIT FACTOR FOR 2021-2022 was presented for passage. Administrator McLauchlin advised that the only change to the Resolution that was passed on September 27 was a correction to an error on the Local Option Sales Tax Credit Factor. Councilman Westbury made a motion to pass and amended Resolution 19-2021. Councilman Nelson seconded and the motion passed unanimously.
- 2. **Resolution 21-2021** AMENDING AN AGREEMENT RELATING TO THE JOINT COUNTY INDUSTRIAL AND BUSINESS PARK OF LEXINGTON AND CALHOUN COUNTIES SO AS TO ENLARGE THE PARK (LONESTAR SOLAR) was tabled until a later meeting.

#### **New Business**

Administrator McLauchlin proposed a one-time bonus to employees who worked during the COVID-19 pandemic. The proposal is for \$1000 to full-time employees, and \$500.00 to

part-time employees who worked during the period of March 19, 2020 to June 30, 2021. The COVID-19 Funds from the Federal American Rescue Plan would fund these bonuses. Councilman Westbury made a motion to pay a one-time bonus to employees who worked during the period March 19, 2020 to June 30, 2021 of \$1000.00 to full-time employees and \$500.00 to part-time employees, with the exception of elected officials. Councilman Thornton seconded the motion. Councilman Nelson noted, for the record, that he would support this motion but that he feels Council should have done something special for first responders and "I just would have done it a different way". After some discussion, a vote was held and the motion passed unanimously.
