CALHOUN COUNTY ANNOUNCES BUILDING RESTRICTIONS

All County Emergency Services remain open and are prepared to respond.

Based on the intelligence collected and recommendations from public health officials, including the CDC, Calhoun County will be enhancing preventative measures to mitigate the spread of the COVID-19 virus. Effective immediately all county buildings will be closed to walk-in traffic from the public. These measures will be evaluated daily and may change without notice.

Residents are encouraged to conduct any business with the county via telephone, email and or through the U.S. Postal Service.
